

Le Raboireau

Le Raboireau is a 12-km long stream. Its source is located a little before Rebais in Bellot and it flows into Le Grand-Morin at Chauffry.

It appears under several names on the map: Raboireau, Resbac and Ru des Etangs. It runs along the bottom of a valley that is about 40 metres deep.

The church of Saint-Denis-lès-Rebais

Its was built during the 13th century. It is dedicated to the collation of the Abbot of Rebais. (Collation: small conference held during the evening among the monks and the light meal they would share after this conference).

Protestant Church

An unusual building in the region: a protestant church built in 1858 in the hamlet of Mazagran, 1.5 km west of Saint-Denis-lès-Rebais.



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Access: Via individual transport: 2 km south-west of Rebais via Rue de Saint-Aile; 11.5 km southwest of Coulommiers by Chauffry and Boissy-le-Châtel • Via public transport: Seine & Marne Express 01 (Transdev network): Melun Station - Coulommiers Station - St Denis-lès-Rebais - Rebais.

Practical information: no food shops, but all shops in Rebais (2 km away).

The Hiker's Code of Conduct

- Do not leave the marked paths.
- If there are any doubts regarding which path to take, markings take precedence over the description.
- Respect nature and private property.
- Don't litter.
- Avoid routes during hunting season (check with the town halls or the Seine-et-Marne hunting federation).
- Close gates and fences after you.
- Whenever possible, remove any obstacles from the path.



Hiking

in Provinois, Bassée-Montois and Morin

SAINT-DENIS-LÈS-REBAIS Le Raboireau

This walk takes you through the heights above Raboireau valley to the Grand-Morin valley and back to Saint-Denis-lès-Rebais through wide open spaces.

- 1 Go past the church porch and follow D61 towards Chauffry. After 450 m, take the path on the left.
- 2 At the cross, turn right and continue on the path to "Le Ménillot" hamlet. At the crossroads, follow the road on the left that leads to the hamlet of "la Brosse". At the fork, turn left onto the street that becomes a path.
- 3 At the end of this path turn left and after 100 m, turn right onto the first path. Follow this path for around 1,300 m through the woods and fields before reaching a crossroads. Take the path on the left that leads to a small road.
- 4 Follow the road to the left until you reach the hamlet of "Bois Gillot".
- 5 After the hamlet, leave the road when it turns left to follow the path opposite. At the first intersection, turn left and then right at the next crossroads. Continue on this path to the church of Saint-Denis-lès-Rebais.



The trail markings on this route are installed and maintained by 250 footpath wardens from the Seine-et-Marne departmental hiking committee. (Codérando 77). It is part of a network of 4,500 km of walking and hiking trails in the department.
