

Saint-Étienne Church

Classified as a "historical monument" since 1930, the parish church has stood the test of time, through attacks, reconstructions and renovations.

La Bassée Nature Reserve

Located south of Éverly, the nature reserve is a predominantly wooded wetland covering 854 hectares. It is home to exceptional natural heritage that can be explored through activities and animations and a discovery trail.

The remains of the castle

All that remains of the castle, built by the Marquis d'Éverly in 1746, is part of the outbuildings, the abandoned farm of la Haye and the southern view.

The Chalmaison wash-house

This communal wash-house, built in 1866 according to plans by architect Charbaut, is supplied with water from Ru des Méances.



CHALMAISON On the banks of Méances stream

Part of the route runs close and then alongside Méances stream. The source of this river lies between Provins and Sourdun, then flows through La Bassée from north to south into the Seine.

On the banks of Méances stream

- 1 Take the street of the town hall. Crossing the railway bridge, turn left and pass the cemetery.
- 2 Turn right, continue the health trail.
- 3 Take the path on the right that leads around the woods.
- 4 Take the fourth path on the left. At the crossroads, follow the 2nd path on the right, cross the railway bridge then take the asphalt road on the left.
- 5 Cross D122 and follow the path leading to the water tower. Once you reach the water tower, take the asphalt road opposite. Turn left, walk down the path through the pasture to the railway. Walk along the railway. After the level crossing, turn right, then take the 2nd on the left.
- 6 Take Rue de Chalmaison to the left, then take the 3rd lane on the right, Chemin des Happes. 300 m later it leads back to Rue de Chalmaison.
- 7 Turn right.
- 8 At the crossroads, turn left, and continue 80m, then turn right. Pass the picnic area and then the wash house (Méances stream). Continue until you come to the main street in Chalmaison. Turn left and return to the church and car park.



The trail markings on this route are installed and maintained by 250 footpath wardens from the Seine-et-Marne departmental hiking committee. (Codérando 77). It is part of a network of 4,500 km of walking and hiking trails in the department.
